

Engine Identification


This manual also refers to engine types not listed in the **Model and System Identification** table. Therefore, be sure to only follow the instructions that apply to the engine in your particular model.


System Identification

Three air conditioning systems are listed in the **Model and System Identification** table as well as the layout of each system's control panel in the center console.

Identify the air conditioning system in your vehicle from the control panel layout and proceed to the appropriate section.

Each section is separated by an easily visible dividing page followed by the job index page. The first page of a typical job description looks like this:

Data and Part Numbers

Technical data, tightening torques and tools are listed at the beginning of each job.

All dimensions are in metric units, unless otherwise indicated. Any part numbers given are only used for identification and easier differentiation between individual components and are not intended for ordering purposes.

When procuring parts from your MB Dealer Parts Department, be sure to specify engine and chassis number (refer to **Vehicle Identification Number Location**).
